You probably noticed the presence of objects, windows, walls and fixtures. My family is in the hardware-store business. As a kid, I used to love playing in the store.

Besides surrounded by the entrepreneurial men and building materials, I was very privileged to have been nurtured by and learned from the strong sensible women in the house; whose cooking, handcrafts and wisdom would soothe anyone's soul. I dedicate my works with patterns, flowers and topics of femininity to them.

At a personal level, I am like many globally integrated nomads who started in the East and ended up in the West. I was born in Indonesia, grew up with conservative Chinese values, spent 20 adult years in Australia and call Berlin/Europe home."
